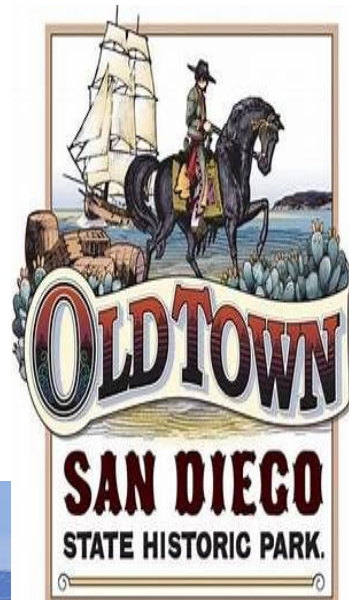

DAY by DAY Itinerary

DAY 1: Depart Redding/Red Bluff areas to Santa Clarita and check-in for our overnight stay. Dinner and evening on your own.

DAY 2: Complimentary breakfast at the Hotel prior to departure for Long Beach where you will be treated to a Gondola tour on the canals of Naples Island with your entertaining gondolier plus enjoy a hosted lunch on the Gondola. This afternoon enjoy a guided tour at the historic Rancho Los Alamitos, twice listed on the list of National Historic Places. Today Rancho Los Alamitos is 7.5-acres, a rare vestige of the original 300,000-acre Los Coyotes land concession given to Manuel Nieto in 1790 for his service on the Gaspar de Portolá expedition to California under the Spanish Crown. However, the story of Rancho Los Alamitos precedes these first newcomers, for the historic site is also part of the ancestral village of the native Gabrielino-Tongva people of the Los Angeles Basin, and still a sacred place. Nieto's vast land holdings included 25,500 acres which in 1833 became Rancho Los Alamitos—Ranch of the Little Cottonwoods. The name suggested its most valuable asset since cottonwoods grow near water, and grew plentifully near the natural springs. For Nieto, the land was a ranching gem and reward from the Spanish Crown. Subsequent owners saw the site as a smart investment and perhaps a haven away from rough Los Angeles. To generations of the Bixby family, the ranch's last private owners, and the workers, tenant and lease farmers who worked there, Rancho Los Alamitos was an enterprising ranch that would endure for almost a century through the rise of modern-day Long Beach. In 1968, the children of Fred and Florence Bixby donated the family ranch to the City of Long Beach, transforming what had been a working ranch to a public oasis and setting the stage for what Rancho Los Alamitos is today—a place for all time. Check in for two nights at the B.W. Plus Hacienda Hotel Old Town. Enjoy a hosted dinner this evening.

DAY 3: Hosted breakfast included at the hotel before departure for Coronado Island - enjoy a leisurely guided walking tour with your Historical Society docent. Learn the history of this world famous San Diego landmark. Free time to explore and enjoy lunch on your own. We have saved the afternoon for you to explore the historic Old Town area (within walking distance of our Hotel). Enjoy dinner on your own, here or back at the Hotel. Tonight we have included a night time Trolley Tour. On this tour, expert guides will navigate you to panoramic views as your trolley drives past notable landmarks, from the magnificent display of lights illuminating the most elegant architecture in the city in Balboa Park to the famous fountain across from the opulent U.S. Grant Hotel, great photo opportunities as you experience this beautiful city from a completely different viewpoint.

DAY 4: Hosted breakfast at the hotel is included before a late check-out and transfer to the beautiful ms Koningsdam - arrive on board in time to enjoy lunch before you sail from San Diego harbor. Enjoy the views on deck at the sail away party.

DAY 5, 6, 7: Settle in, unpack and enjoy the many amenities, entertainment and activities on board this luxurious ship as you sail north to Vancouver, B.C. All meals and entertainment on board included.

DAY 8: Enjoy breakfast on board prior to an early morning departure. Transfer to Charter Bus of British Columbia and travel to Bellingham where you will be met by your Mt. Lassen motor coach to begin the journey home. No host lunch stop en route. Overnight accommodations in Salem, Oregon at the B.W. Mill Creek Inn. Dinner on your own this evening.

Day 9: Hosted breakfast prior to departure. Sit back and relax with wonderful memories of this great tour. No host lunch stop.
